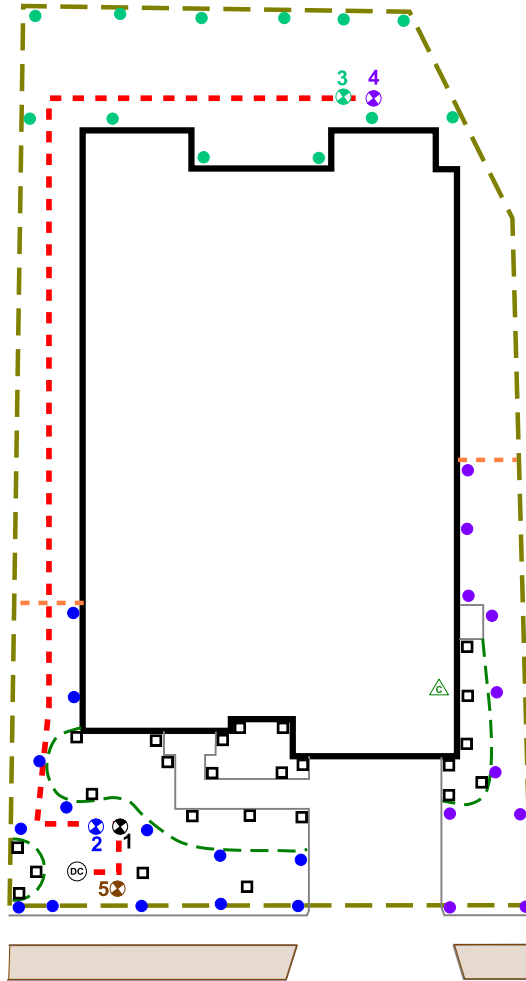

Recommended Maintenance

- Backflow – Test Annually
- Filter – Check Annually for debris
- Heads – Run system monthly checking for leaks or broken heads
- Valve Covers – Trim grass to keep exposed
- Controller – Seasonal update programming
- Winter – Run system briefly every 2 weeks if system turned off
